

WARSAW MUSIC ACADEMY SECURITY PROCEDURE
in relation to the health regime caused by the COVID-19 pandemic
in the school year 2021/2022

1. The purpose of this procedure is to introduce safety rules aimed at minimising the risk of COVID-19 infection at Warsaw Music Academy, located at 326 Pryzyczkowska St., 02-962 Warsaw (hereinafter referred to as "the Institution").
2. This procedure applies to all persons on the premises of the Institution.
3. Persons shall not be allowed to stay in the Institution:
 - a. people who have symptoms of a respiratory tract infection;
 - b. who have tested positive to a genetic or antigen test for SARS-CoV-2 virus within the previous 14 days;
 - c. who have had an increase in body temperature or fever within the previous 24 hours;
 - d. whose housemates are in quarantine or isolation in a home environment.
4. Parents and legal guardians who bring children should limit entry to the Institution's premises to the minimum necessary, taking extra precautions, in particular::
 - a. obligatory hand disinfection;
 - b. obligatory temperature measurement.
 - c. covering the nose and mouth; and
 - d. maintaining a distance of 1.5 metres.
5. The obligation to cover the nose and mouth does not apply to students in the rooms where classes are held.
6. Used personal protective equipment (e.g. masks, gloves) should be disposed of in a specially marked container.
7. All premises within the Institution are cleaned and disinfected on an ongoing basis.
8. Items that cannot be disinfected will be removed on an ongoing basis or may not be brought onto Institution premises.
9. In the case of reasonable suspicion or the occurrence of COVID-19 symptoms, the teacher may isolate the student from the group and shall notify the principal and parents or legal guardians if the student is a minor.

10. In the event that COVID-19 infection is confirmed in one or more participants in a particular dance group, the sanitary inspectorate may decide to temporarily quarantine all students in that group.
11. In the event that the situation mentioned in 9 above arises, or in the event that the government imposes restrictions in a particular area/town or across the country that prevent regular classes from being held, all regular classes will be converted to online classes. If a student is unable to attend an online class, he/she may attend the class at a later date.
